Infrastructure Development – The scale

- President Trump's plan: US\$1.5 trillion
 infrastructure improvements over 10 years
- Infrastructure needed in Asia Pacific: **US\$1.7 trillion/year**

US\$1 trillion

- Belt and Road Initiative:
 Chinese outbound investment over 10 years
 - Asian Infrastructure Investment Bank (AIIB)
 - Silk Road Fund

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- ExIm Bank of China
- China Development Bank
- New Development Bank (BRICS)
- Other multilateral institutions (ADB, World Bank...)

Infrastructure Development

US companies to note

Characteristics

- Often large-scale infrastructure development
- More **sovereignty-based**, increasing role of multilateral institutions
- Many cross-border projects
- Financing, contracting

What expertise needed from the US and HK?

- Government affairs, consulting
- Legal, accounting, insurance, arbitration, cost control, due diligence, risk management
- Planning, design, construction, engineering, urban solutions, tech
- Project management, project finance, debt financing

Infrastructure Development – First-mover Opportunities?

- Caterpillar +22% sales in Asia Pacific, Q4 2017
- General Electric
 - 2016: US\$2.3 billion deal; US\$413.5 million high-powered locomotives CPEC
 - Energy infrastructure investment platform jointly set up with Silk Road Fund
- **Honeywell** ...increased significantly our presence in central Asia
- Weg Brazil manufacturer of electrical & electronic equipment
- Waters S&P500 analytical instruments & software: Healthy China 2030
- **Chubb** 10-year strategic cooperation agreement with PICC
- WorleyParsons "track record with Chinese businesses internationally"
- Siemens US\$1 billion order from China's SEPCOIII for the construction of a combined cycle power plant in Saudi Arabia

US companies to note

Characteristics

- Connectivity to global supply chain
- Capability to trade, trade policy, labor, resources
- Logistics
- Non-tariff barriers, standards
- Culture and taste

What expertise?

 Logistics, supply chain management, manufacturing technology & processing, industrial park management, quality control, environment-related engineering, e-commerce, branding and marketing

What's next for US exporters and manufacturers?

- Asia's export-development model to replicate in Belt & Road region?
- New trade route? New global value chain? New trade pattern?
- New consumers? New demand from emerging market?

...and **new challenges** too due to the **heterogeneity** of the markets and the customers? ...and emerging markets with mostly **small** businesses

Trade Development – First-mover Opportunities?

- China trade volume with Belt & Road countries
 - US\$296 billion (+12.9%), or 27.5% of China trade (Q1, 2018)
- IBM x Pacific International Lines blockchain platform for cargo management via the Belt & Road Southern Transport Corridor
- Li & Fung "Land transport allows manufacturers to transport their products between China and Europe in less than half the time of shipping by sea at a fraction of the cost of shipping by air"
- SSA Marine, Conti Group Georgia's Anaklia sea port along B&R route
- Citigroup, HSBC, Standard Chartered: capital market solutions
