### **OASES Commenced Full Operation**

Office for Attracting Strategic Enterprises (OASES) is one of the new initiatives of the Hong Kong Government to attract enterprises and investments more proactively and aggressively with a view to enhancing the city's competitiveness and speeding up industry development. Tasked with attracting representative and high-potential strategic enterprises from around the globe, the office will reach out to target industries proactively, provide tailor-made plans to facilitate the setting up of the operations of enterprises, and provide employees of target enterprises with one-stop facilitation services.



### **Dedicated Team for Attracting Businesses and Talents**

Hong Kong aims to strengthen the attraction for enterprises and investment to enhance the momentum of economic development and to attract global talent to the city with a view to injecting impetus to the city's growth. As part of the effort to attract enterprises, investment and talents, a Dedicated Team for Attracting Businesses and Talents has been set up in the Hong Kong Economic and Trade Office in San Francisco. The team will proactively reach out to target enterprises and talents and invite them to pursue development and opportunities in Hong Kong.

### **Launch of Talents Service Unit Online Platform**

The online platform of the Talents Service Unit (TSU) is now ready to attract talents from all over the world. It enables talents to obtain information on the various talent admission schemes and submit applications more easily. The platform provides onestop electronic services for talents from around the world. After entering the landing page, users can browse all kinds of practical information, including Hong Kong's advantages and development opportunities, details of the various talent admission schemes, as well as information on the necessities of living in Hong Kong. Potential applicants can use the online platform's Talent Admission Scheme Matching Tool to find out the schemes they are eligible for, and then immediately proceed to the Immigration Department's "e-Visa" platform to submit applications online.



### **I&T Development Blueprint Unveiled**

Hong Kong unveiled (December 22) its Innovation and Technology (I&T) Development Blueprint to set out a clear development path and formulate systematic strategic planning for I&T development over the next 5 to 10 years. The Government will take forward the blueprint under four broad development directions: to enhance the I&T ecosystem and promote "new industrialization" in Hong Kong; to enlarge the I&T talent pool and to create a strong impetus for growth; to promote digital economy development and develop Hong Kong into a smart city; and to integrate into the overall national development and consolidate the city's role as a bridge connecting the Mainland and the world.



### **Hong Kong Welcomes Global Talents and Enterprises**

Hong Kong is rolling out a series of initiatives and measures to attract talent and enterprises from around the world, with the Office for Attracting Strategic Enterprises starting full operation on December 23. In addition, the Talents Service Unit portal has also been launched to provide one-stop electronic services for talent from around the world. The city has enhanced its Technology Talent Admission Scheme by lifting the local employment requirement. Meanwhile, the newly introduced Top Talent Pass Scheme is now open for applications.



## The Year in ASEAN: Rising Challenges Amid Strong Post-Pandemic Recovery



As of the end of 2021, expectations were high that the strong post-pandemic recovery already evident within the ASEAN bloc would continue to gather pace in 2022. With the exception of Brunei Darussalam and Myanmar, all of the bloc's constituent nations had recorded positive GDP growth, with Singapore and the Philippines leading the charge at 7.6% and 5.7%, respectively, while Laos (2.5%) and Thailand (1.6%) brought up the rear.

At the time, the key driver of ASEAN's recovery was the pent-up consumer demand that characterised both its domestic and major external markets. Its overall level of foreign direct investment (FDI) was also up, as global manufacturers, caught on the hop by pandemic-induced trade bottlenecks, sought to diversify their supply chains. With its fast-growing youthful, digitally savvy population another plus for investors, the bloc benefitted from particularly strong FDI inflow in its manufacturing, financial and insurance sectors.

As 2022 progressed, however, major economic headwinds started to gust across the globe. The inflationary pressures already apparent in 2021 accelerated in February as the Russia-Ukraine conflict escalated, a development that saw oil, gas and grain prices soar. In a bid to rein in these spiralling price rises, the US Federal Reserve then introduced a series of aggressive rate hikes, which saw the value of the dollar strengthen against many Asian currencies.

The situation was subsequently exacerbated with economic growth decelerating in the US, China and many major European markets as regulators prioritised controlling inflation and businesses struggled to overcome supply side constraints. Inevitably, this both dampened demand for exports from the ASEAN region and curtailed the bloc's investment inflows. As a result, during the last six months of 2022, most ASEAN economies were having to contend with reduced export demand, an escalating cost of living and soaring import prices.


